Dear Mr. Morgen:

Recently you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-2B-C 10868, Camden, New Jersey. The issue in this case is whether management violated Article 37 by administering a Window Clerk examination 49 days after the grievant had completed training. It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

- 1. The Window Clerk examination is to be conducted on the last day of training. In the instant case, this did not happen.
- If the grievant so desires, he will be allowed to retrain and take a timely examination. If he passes the examination, he will be placed in the next window clerk vacancy.
- 3. The grievant will have 30 days from the date of this settlement to advise the Postmaster, in writing, if he so desires to be trained as a window clerk.

Please sign the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing B8C-2B-C 10868 from the pending national arbitration listing.
