On September 29, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The issue in this case is whether management was proper in posting a Relief and Pool Distribution Window Clerk duty assignment with Accountable Papers Clerk duties as needed.

It is our mutual understanding that the disputed relief assignment was properly posted and filled in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding dated March 3, 1975 and Article 37, Section 3.F.9 of the National Agreement.
