Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On September 19, 1985 and September 30, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management properly scheduled the grievant on a different tour.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This is a local dispute suitable for regional determination by application of the Memorandum of Understanding dated March 3, 1975 regarding relief and pool assignments and Article 37.3F(9) to the fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
