Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On May 4, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether adding the language "and all other stations as assigned" on job postings for Pool Assignment positions conflicts with Article 37, Section 3, E of the National Agreement.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We agreed that this issue may be resolved by application of the Pool & Relief Assignment Memorandum of Understanding of 1975.


Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
