

Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On November 17, 1988, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether Article 37, Section 3.F.9 provides for a relief position which consists of a Manual level 5 with LSM level 6 relief.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We further agreed that Article 37, Section 3.F.9 does not provide for this relief position.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
