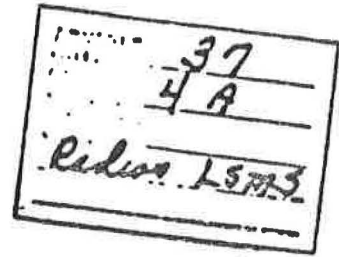

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On May 11, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved the placement of portable radios on LSM consoles.


After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no National interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. We agreed that the policy set forth in Postal Bulletin 21397, dated March 31, 1983, applies in this case.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.
