Staples and the U.S. Postal Service have cut a deal that jeopardizes your mail service and your local post office. In fact, post offices across the country are at risk – along with thousands of good jobs.

The Staples deal is replacing full-service U.S. Post Offices with knock-off post offices in Staples stores that are not staffed with U.S. Postal Service employees.

You have a right to post offices staffed by workers who are accountable to you and the American people. You have a right to postal services provided by highly-trained, uniformed Postal Service employees, who are sworn to safeguard your mail.

If Staples and the USPS continue this deal, it could lead to the end of the Postal Service as we know it. Since the USPS-Staples deal began, the Postal Service has reduced hours at nearby post offices. Staples has closed more than 170 stores — with no notice and no input from the community. What if those stores had replaced the post offices in those neighborhoods? Who would serve the residents once Staples closed?

In addition to damaging service, the Staples deal is replacing living-wage jobs that our community depends on with low-wage jobs that hurt our economy.

Our postal services don't belong in a struggling company whose only allegiance is to its shareholders. Boycott Staples and its subsidiary, Quill.com.
